Teacher Degree Apprenticeship: Secondary Maths

Introducing the Teacher Degree Apprenticeship!
This is a new and the only employment-based, fully-funded route to becoming a qualified teacher.



Who is the Teacher Degree Apprenticeship (TDA) for?

Anyone without a degree who wants to become a qualified teacher. For example:

- Sixth-form or college leavers with A Level qualifications (or equivalent).
- School-based support staff, such as teaching assistants or HLTAs.
- Vocational or industry works looking to change careers.

What subject is the TDA in?

Secondary Mathematics.

This is specifically for the teaching of mathematics to pupils aged 11-16 and courses delivered at Key Stages 3 and 4.

As this is a new scheme, the Department for Education (DfE) is trialling the TDA in Secondary Mathematics only at this stage. It is anticipated that more subjects will become available at a later stage.

How will the TDA work?

- The TDA in Secondary Maths is a 4-year programme of work and study.
- The programme will start September 2025.
- You will work in a school from day one of the apprenticeship and for the duration of the programme.
- You will be employed by SHARE Multi-Academy Trust as a 'Teacher Degree Apprentice' for the duration of the apprenticeship and will be paid by us at the min. of the unqualified teacher payscale (UTP).
- Training is also fully-funded by the Department for Education (DfE) and SHARE Multi-Academy Trust.
- You will study at the University of Huddersfield.
- You will split your working week between working in one of our schools (60% of your time = 3 days) and study at the university (40% of your time = 2 days).
- By completing the apprenticeship, you will gain an undergraduate degree and Qualified Teacher Status (QTS).

What is the eligibility criteria for the TDA?

Entrants will require the following qualifications to be eligible to apply for the TDA:

- GCSEs at grade 4 (C) for above in English Language and Mathematics.
- 3 A level qualifications or equivalent, including Mathematics or cognate subject.*
- Be a resident of England for the last 3 years or more, and be aged 16 or over

*Accredited Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) will be considered if applicants do not hold these qualifications.
