Early Career Framework

Engagement with the ECF programme continues to be good. Since September, we have seen: Over 250 ECTs and over 250 mentors trained, almost 3000 feedback meetings held, over 2300 action steps met.

ECT

Cohort 2022/23 - Change to ECT registration process

The DfE have amended the process for ECT registration. From mid-May, the [Manage your Early Career Teacher](#) service will be streamlined. Schools will receive an email informing them of what they need to do – this will include indicating whether they will have ECTs in 2022 or not, indicating who the lead provider for the ECF is (we work with Ambition Institute) and indicating any changes to ECTs or mentors already on the programme. We will support schools with implementing this change later in May.

Before the end of term, you will also be asked which Appropriate Body you will be using to quality assure ECT induction. [We provide this service](#) via ECT Manager and can help you manage all your ECTs in one place. Other choices locally include Kirklees LA and Calderdale LA.

[Funding for NQTs completing induction Summer 2021/Spring 2022](#)

The DfE have clarified that there will be funding to support the development of NQTs who completed their induction in a state funded school between Summer 2021 and Spring 2022. £1,200 will be paid directly to schools eligible later this year. Schools who have employed NQTs who have moved school post-induction will still be eligible to receive this funding. NPQs

Alongside our six current NPQ programmes, two further NPQs will be available from Autumn 2022:

* **NPQ for Leading Literacy (NPQLL)** - For teachers who have or are aspiring to have responsibilities for leading literacy across a school, a year group, a key stage or phase.

* **NPQ for Early Years Leadership (NPQEYL)** - For leaders qualified to at least level 3 with a full and relevant qualification, who are or are aspiring to be managers of private, voluntary and independent nurseries, head teachers of school based or maintained nurseries, or childminders with leadership responsibilities.
